ENVIRONMENTAL SCIENCE RESOURCE GRANTS

\$1,000 Grants to Enhance Environmental Science Curriculum in Bay Area Schools

WHAT IS IT?

Grants of up to \$1,000 will be awarded to teachers to enhance classroom environmental science curriculum through projects, supplies, field trips, and professional development.

Examples include:

- Field trip related to the study of wetland restoration and water conservation
- In-classroom presentations on endangered species by local wildlife experts
- Gardening supplies for students to build a wildlife habitat

WHO CAN APPLY?

Any TK-12 teacher working at a low-income public school in Alameda, Contra Costa, Marin, Napa, Solano, Sonoma, Santa Clara, San Francisco or San Mateo County is eligible to apply.

A maximum of five grants will be awarded to a school per school year, and one grant per teacher.

HOW TO APPLY?

It's easy! Submit a request on school letterhead with the following information:

•Date and notation on top that request is for an Environmental Science Grant

- School and district name, address, and telephone number
- •Your name, grade level, email address
- •Description of your classroom
- Title 1 status and/or percentage of students eligible for Free and Reduced- Price Lunch
- •Total amount requested
- Item by Item listing of how the money will be spent
 Who the check should be made payable to (school, district or PTA only) and the address the check should be mailed to
 Applications must be signed by both the submitting teacher and principal
